breast biopsies – with experienced care providers to cover all potential outcomes.

This speeds the processes for patients whose initial diagnostics reveal a concern, yielding further diagnostics and guidance as soon as possible – including same-day appointments if appropriate.

As part of these changes, **Lisa Logue, FNP-C, ACON** is now on hand to offer her expertise in oncology and treatment planning. **The Breast Center** also offers access to a patient risk assessment as well as genetic counseling and testing. This supplies providers with additional data in determining a patient’s risk level based on family history and overall breast health.

Longstreet Clinic recently unveiled our re-imagined, state-of-the-art Breast Center program in Gainesville. This multidisciplinary program is dedicated to precision diagnoses and treatment plans for all breast health conditions. Most importantly, our Breast Center streamlined the process so that patients can avoid the stress of long wait times and the hassles of coordinating multiple care providers.

LONGSTREET URGENT CARE OFFERS BENEFITS

It should be a cut-and-dried answer, but it's not always easy to decide what level of care you should choose if you are suffering with an injury or illness.

Many issues can be treated with a call and appointment with your Primary Care Physician. There are times when you want a health issue solved immediately or after regular hours and are forced to choose between Urgent Care or a trip to the Emergency Room.

Let's face it, you'd always rather avoid a hospital emergency room visit – not only due to wait lines and inconveniences, but also simple cost. ER visits are expensive and almost always result in long wait times for non-emergent needs.

And since Longstreet Clinic's Urgent Care is part of our Primary Care practice, urgent care visits are subject to the same co-pay as visits to your PCP.

It might also surprise you to know that a 2015 Centers for Disease Control survey revealed that, of 136.9 million emergency room visits, only 9% resulted in admission to the hospital for further care, and only 1% resulted in admission to the critical care unit. This means most conditions seen in the ER could have
