GROWTH, RENOVATIONS CONTINUE ACROSS LONGSTREET CAMPUSES

Because Longstreet Clinic is committed to continual evolution and advancement of patient care, that often necessitates physical growth and enhancements across our campuses. And now is no different, especially at our Gainesville/main campus, where the first of five stages of construction are underway.

You may have already noticed many of these changes beginning to take place including the removal of the illuminated signs with our old logos on the Jesse Jewell side of the building and a complete repainting of the building.

We have also begun the first stage of Phase 1 on the third floor-which includes the renovation and expansion of Oncology, Diabetic Education, and a small section of the **Department** of Medicine. This entire project is scheduled to be completed in February.

Immediately following the completion of the Phase 1 work, we will begin the renovation and refresh of OBGYN on the second floor. Once complete, phase 3 construction will begin across the second-floor atrium in the former administrative space to move the Perinatology Clinic to a more convenient location to our OBGYN department. Part of this space will also be renovated for the EPIC, IT Teams and Population Health teams.

Phase 4 includes new space for the **Center** for Weight Management in the former Perinatology suite. And, finally, the final phase of renovations for **Urgent Care** is still in the planning stages but scheduled

for late 2023. The plan is to move Urgent Care to the first floor where the Pharmacy and Center for Weight Management suites were in order to enhance access to our walk-in and after-hours services.
